



VILLAGE OF LOUGHEED
BYLAW 750-15

BEING A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF LOUGHEED, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF LOUGHEED LAND USE BYLAW NO. 705.

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Lougheed considers it necessary to amend the Land Use Bylaw No. 705, and

WHEREAS, the Council has the authority pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000, Chapter M26, to amend the said Land Use Bylaw No. 705,

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Lougheed, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

THAT the Land Use Bylaw No. 705 Section 9: Definitions be hereby amended as follows:

"LOT" means an area of land, the boundaries of which are shown on a plan registered in a Land Titles Office, or are described in the Certificate of Title to the land, and that has not been divided into smaller areas by any plan or instrument registered in the Land Titles Office and has no more than One (1) Linc number. The words **site** and **parcel** shall have the same meaning as the word **lot**.

This Bylaw shall come into force and effect upon the date that it is finally passed.

READ a first time this 20 day of August, 2015.

READ a second time this 20 day of August, 2015.

Read a third and final time and finally passed this 20 day of August, 2015.
