**A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF LOUGHEED IN
THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AMEND THE
BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGULATION OF
STREETS AND THOROUGHFARES IN THE
VILLAGE OF LOUGHEED**

WHEREAS the *Traffic Safety Act* authorizes a municipality to regulate and control vehicle traffic as well as parking on streets and property within the Village;

AND WHEREAS the *Municipal Government Act* allows a municipality to pass Bylaws as well as designate authority concerning streets under its direction, control, and management;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council or the Village of Lougheed in the Province of Alberta enacts a Bylaw to regulate Vehicle Traffic in the Village of Lougheed as follows:

AND THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Lougheed in the Province of Alberta to the Bylaw 804-22 to provide for "***Use of Flashing Green Lights.***" This Bylaw may also be cited as the Village of Lougheed "Traffic Bylaw."

- This Bylaw may be cited as "Bylaw 820-24, amending bylaw 773-18 and bylaw 804-22, Village of Lougheed "Traffic Bylaw" as follows:
- Section 5, "Traffic Control Devices," is amended by adding Part F. "USE OF FLASHING GREEN LIGHTS."
- Section 5 Part F. Use of Flashing Green Lights to read:

- (a) Full-time or volunteer firefighters may carry, on, or in a vehicle other than an emergency vehicle. This lamp produces intermittent flashes of green light and may operate the lamp if the vehicle is proceeding to a fire or other emergency.
 - (b) No person other than a full-time or volunteer firefighter shall operate a lamp that produces intermittent flashes of green light.
 - (c) Nothing in this section shall be construed as to permit a full-time or volunteer firefighter to operate a vehicle in contravention of the *Traffic Safety Act*, Provincial regulations, or this Bylaw.
- If any portion of this Bylaw is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the invalid portion shall be severed, and the remainder of the Bylaw is deemed valid.
 - This By-law becomes effective on the date it is signed and passed.


