Council Highlights- May 22, 2019 Meeting

- ◆ Council is offering Lougheed resident a designated area & pickup service for disposal of branches and twigs.
- ◆ Council has finalized the 1st, 2nd & 3th reading for Master Rate Bylaw No. 781-19, 2019 Taxation Rates Bylaw No. 782-19 & 2019 Taxation Penalties Bylaw 783-19.
- ◆ Council has approved of a Diabetes Donation Clothing Bin to be placed in Lougheed.

Flagstaff Intermunicipal Partnership Meeting Notes—May 6, 2019

Regional Broadband Project- Craig Dobson of Taylor Warwick conducted a brief presentation on the potential development a fiber optics system that would cover the entire Flagstaff region, including all towns, villages and hamlets. Flagstaff County Economic Development department will be coordinating the development of a proposal to develop a business plan for a region-wide fiber optics system.

Regional Governance Project- New West Opportunities has been retained to develop a detailed operation and transition plan for the potential amalgamation of all participating municipalities (Flagstaff County, Towns of Daysland, Hardisty, and Killam and Villages of Alliance, Forestburg, Heisler and Lougheed). The cost of this phase of the project is being covered 100% by a provincial grant. This phase of the project is to be completed by the end of November, 2019
