## February 20, 2020 Council Meetings Highlights

- ◆ Council approved Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework with Flagstaff County
- ◆ Council approved M. Hampshire & P. Miller to serve on IARB & FRSAB for three (3) year term, expiring Feb. 2023
- ◆ Council approved J. Lundy to serve on IARB for a three (3) year term, expiring Feb. 2023
- ◆ Council entered into a one (1) year contract with the Town of Killam to operate the Village of Lougheed Water Treatment Plant & Lift Stations with the fee presented, \$30,000.00/ yr.
- ◆ Council accepts the 2020 Interim Operating Budget based on the 2019 approved Operating Budget.
- ◆ Council is continuing to support Battle River 4-H Club this year by purchasing flowers for the summer 2020.
- ◆ Council approves the renewal of the Peace Officer Service Agreement commences March 1, 2020 for a three (3) year term expiring on Feb. 28, 2023.

### Cost recovery on new Policing & Flagstaff Regional Emergency Services fees.
