ATCO Gas - Upgrading Meter Technology

ATCO Gas has been in the Village dropping off notices. The notices are in regards to ATCO and their contractors Corix Utilities and Itron Inc. ATCO and their contractors will be in the Village to install transmitters on your gas meter. The notice stated this should take about 10 minutes to complete.

Staff with ATCO and their contractors will have photo identification tags issued by ATCO gas to identify them as working for or with ATCO gas. If ATCO gas or the Contractor can not access your natural gas meter, they will contact you in or-

der to make arrangements to upgrade the meter.

Once the meters have been upgraded, you will see ATCO gas driving through the Village collecting readings from the meters.

With this new technology, ATCO gas will no longer need to gain access to your home to read your natural gas meter.
