## WATER

During the next 2 months the Village will be contacting those property owners who still need a water meter installed, to schedule an access time. Once the remaining meters have been installed, there will be a process of ensuring their reporting accuracy. You may be contacted to verify water meter serial numbers, etc.

Consumption usage should begin showing up on your next billing, however will not be charged until Bylaw 740-15—Master Rates Bylaw has been revisited, with Council determining the new infrastructure and consumption charges.
