The Village of Lougheed would like to remind all citizens that in accordance of Bylaw 689 Dog Control bylaw section

4.1 No owner shall cause, or allow or permit another person to cause, his dog to be or to be on any property not his own unless:

(a) a leash of sufficient strength is used to restrain the dog., And not longer than 1.5 meters, is securely attached to the dog.

(b) the leash is securely held by a person able to restrain the dog.

The Village of Lougheed does not have an off leash area.

The Lougheed Walking Path/Beautification Committee had a busy year in 2012. The total number of Flower Barrels planted was increased by 12, a successful Cemetery Clean Up was held, three shrub beds were planted on the berm beside Highway 13, 55 spruce trees were moved from behind the school to the west side of town and we hope to have a few "Winter Bouquet" barrels sprinkled around the Village. A hearty and dedicated crew of volunteers cleaned 20 km. during the annual Highway Clean Up to pay for the increased flowers and shrubs. It should also be mentioned that Sheila Smith of Lougheed Gift and Garden made these plantings possible with a generous donation to the beautification of our town. This year we hope to plant a small windbreak on the Village boulevard just west of the Post Office, continue with the flower barrels, and carry on with the relocation of trees that are now being sheltered behind the school.

The Walking Path committee applied for a recreational grant from the County of Flagstaff to widen and resurface the western portion (1 Km.) of the existing path but were unfortunately refused. We had hoped to go ahead with the funding we do have, unfortunately, our equipment required an upgrade but we are determined to complete this project in the spring.

We would like to thank our volunteers this past year: Janice Bishop, Cliff and Cheryl Grove, Greta and Maria Krahn, Jody Lynn Rarick, Karen Bovencamp, Ryan Manning, Owen, Tammy and Brent Thompson, Pat Martin, Bruce Bovencamp and Dennis Bergseth. Picking garbage in the pouring rain is never fun but you persevered and the coffers looked much better because of it. Dennis gave us time from his days off to help water containers and Janice has been tending the trees behind the school. Thank you all!
