LAND USE BY-LAW 776-18

8.12 LANDSCAPING

(1) A landscaping plan may be required by the Development Authority. If required, a landscaping plan shall contain the following information for the site adjacent boulevards:

(a) all physical features, existing or proposed, including shrubs, trees, flower beds, berm contours, walls, fences, outdoor furniture, surface utilities, and decorative paving with (b) all shrubs and trees, whether existing or proposed labelled by their common name and size.
