DISCHARGING OF FIREWORKS AND FIREARMS IN THE VILLAGE OF LOUGHEED BYLAW 803-21

FIREWORKS— is classified as **EXPLOSIVES!** - A fireworks permit is required to sell fireworks within the Municipality— and also a permit is required to engage in a prohibited activity and a Permit is required by the **Regional Fire Services.**

FIREARMS— www.rcmp-grc.gc.ca/en/firearms

Majority of BB, pellet, and Airsoft guns are not firearms as defined by the Criminal Code of Canada, or the firearms act. **However, any gun or replica thereof, used in an offence, is considered to be a firearm and treated as such under the criminal code.** Even though they don't qualify as firearms under The Firearms Act, they're still covered under municipal by-laws in most jurisdictions unless you take them indoors on private property. All pellet guns qualify as weapons under The Criminal Code if used inappropriately.
